

Remarks on Board Saturday Sept 16 68
Employed in mending sails at 4 pm took the masts of 2 masts
on board & stowed it below thick and squally winds
from North the shipper Gales abated at 4 pm
Mrs Silva went on shore for the night took the boat
ashore at 7 am & got ready for the things
from the shore to ship. Said I was present

Remarks on Board Sunday Sept 17
Fine pleasant weather lying at anchor
then part of the crew left the boat & the crew went on
shore for the day. Winds from S. thick & light
rain the masts on shore so ends

Remarks on Board Monday Sept 18
at anchor & the crew on shore at night the crew
on board & at 6 the masts went on shore till 7 am
at 8 the anchor was set as usual. wind not winds
from S. 3 sails left the boat at 7 am the watch came
on board took a boat load of rigging & other things on
board & other sails

Remarks on Board Tuesday Sept 19
Fine pleasant weather Employed in mending
things on board Beef Pork & bread 3 bread 12 beef &
six of Pork & a cask of Molasses & bushels Potatoes & so
Pumpkins 100 lbs of Sugar a stick of timber & Gun
at 4 am watch went on shore for the night present
Jackson Drunk but present Mr Silva went ashore
the crew came on board all but Belcher at 7 am took on
board Coal & Molasses & Onions & Potatoes & stowed them
below at 10 am in morning anchored a head of us she drifted
shore too us we moved out 10 fathoms more Chome
Belcher on shore

Remarks on Board Wednesday Sept 20 68
light winds from N lying at anchor Employed in stowing
away things below at night Mr Silva went on shore
for the night Belcher stowed there found the Windlass
Gear out of order & would not work at 6 am went
shore got a Carpenter to come on board to fix the wind
Potter Gear at 7 Belcher came on board at 9 am
on board Onions & Tarron & Pumpkins & put
wedda for Sea too Drunk arrived lying off and on
this day at 10 am still at anchor

Remarks on Board Thursday Sept 21
at anchor the boat a passage to the shore & coming
to the Schooner getting things on board Mr Silva
went on shore for the night fine present weather
winds from S. & never light at 6 pm an English Schooner
came at anchor at 7 am Mr Silva came on
board got ready to go to Sea the boat a passage to the
shore & getting things on board at 9 am took up the
anchor & lay off so ends

Remarks on Board Friday Sept 22
lying off at 3 pm Steamed S.S. at night
Fargo West point have N.E. & S.W. 15 miles & 10
from E.S. & 10 miles showed Cable below &
anchors on each took up the sheets & other sails in the
batter points stronger Gales from E Steaming to S.E.
with reefed sails all well on board & prime Sept 23 10

Remarks on Board Saturday Sept 23
stronger Gales from E. Steaming to S.E. & with reefed
sails at night Chase reefed thick & drizzle weather
middle & batter points stronger winds from E Steaming
S.E. & with reefed sails small weather & high Sea
Sept by obs 34-12
