thick weather winds from S.W. to S. by E. steering W. by N
took ship to S.E. at 10th took sail to 3/4 set
at daylight set sail & steered S.E. & at 10th
set up head rigging & other sails. Lat 6, 56

Remarks on board Tuesday Nov 14
heavy weather Winds from S.W. to S. by E.
steering S.E. & at 10th shortened sail
at 8 pm by 1/2 at daylight set sail & steered
S.E. & saw nothing of note to send up to main
heavy weather Lat 6, 58 Long 10 30

Remarks on board Wednesday Nov 15
moderate winds from S.W. steering S.E. & with all
sail sent up foremast at 10th took ship to
W. & at daylight set sail, strange winds Lat 6, 56

Remarks on board Thursday November 16
strange winds from S.W. steering S.E. & at
10th took ship to S.E. & shortened sail at daylight
set sail steered South on a wind with moderate sail
employed in pitching fore & aft & other sails
had some business from the boats & seen
a boat with a crew on a river he was a burlesque
to the Captain. Lat 6, 31

Remarks on board Friday November 17-1865
strange winds from S.W. & W. by S. steering S.E.
at 10th shortened sail at 8 pm by 1/2 at daylight
set sail & at 10th heavy weather & at 10th
other sails at 10th took ship to W. & at 6-57

Remarks on board Saturday Nov 18
moderate winds from W. by S. & heavy weather
steering S.E. & at 10th sent up fore & topmast yards
at 6 took ship to S.E. & at 10th shortened sail
at daylight set sail & steered to S.E. & at 10th
at 10th took ship to W. & at 10th shortened sail
Lat 6, 56 Long 6, 44

Remarks on board Sunday Nov 19
fine pleasant weather steering S.E. & at 6 pm
took ship to W. & at 10th shortened sail at daylight
set sail & steered S.E. & at 10th moderate winds from S.W.
saw Pepper's fine pleasant weather Lat 6, 09 Long 12, 26

sail at 8 pm saw the land being S.E. by E. distant
30 miles at 6 pm took ship to W. & at daylight
saw a sail to the West of us at 8 am took ship to

ge. & saw fine pleasant weather Lat 6, 00

Remarks on board Tuesday Nov 21
fine pleasant weather Winds from S.W. steering
S.E. & saw Humphreys & Pepper's in company
with a Palmyra Schooner at 6 pm took ship
to W. & at 10th a Pepper's employed in ship's
duties & saw other sails set up both ways
strange winds & heavy Lat 5, 54
