fine present weather engaged in fishing  
fore & aft yard Mr. Lita had some growlin  
about fitting backstay he said he did not ship  
carpenter the first ship he did not own things  
& other growl with unpleas'd letters that was cut  
of place to be Captain as an officer he behav'd bad  
middle & better parts morn'nd sent up fine top sail &  
other tubes. Lat 14<sup>o</sup> 10'

brisk breeze from S.E. steering S.W. to S.W.  
with fore & aft sails heavy weather middle &  
better present steering S.W. Lat 14<sup>o</sup> 44'  
Long 123<sup>o</sup> 40'

Remarks on board Friday Dec 14<sup>th</sup>  
fine present weather winds from S.E. steering S.W.  
except by breeze & flower middle & better parts  
S.E. steering S.W. by S. better part thick & haze  
no sail by day  
12 on coast 11 45

Remarks on board Saturday Dec 15<sup>th</sup>  
brisk breeze from S.E. steering S.W. by S. with all  
sail thick haze weather & sun the sea morn'nd  
better part brisk gales from S.E. Lat 14<sup>o</sup> 46'

Remarks on board Sunday Dec 16<sup>th</sup>  
heavy weather winds from S.E. steering S.W. by S.  
middle & better parts strange winds at 4 am  
saw the land St. Helena bearing W.S.W. dist 40 miles  
at 7 in a sail to S.E. of us at 10 shee past us the ship  
then Rogers of Gloucester seen the Island bore W.S.W. dist  
40 miles heavy weather Lat 16<sup>o</sup> 00'

Remarks on board Monday Dec 17<sup>th</sup>  
morn'nd winds from S.E. to S.W. steering S.W.  
at daylight St. Helena bore W.S.W. dist 40 miles  
N.N.W. to S.W. part shrouled sail morn'nd  
winds middle & better parts by 11 winds engaged  
in repairing mainsail at noon the Island bore  
S.E. dist 30 miles

Remarks on board Tuesday Dec 18<sup>th</sup>  
light winds from S.E. & S.W. steering in a wind to S.E.  
at 4 pm tack ship to S.W. at daylight the Island  
bore W.S.W. dist 40 miles shrouled sail at daylight  
none ship to S.E. at 5 pm set sail morn'nd  
morn'nd at noon the Island bore S.E. dist 16 15'

Remarks on board Wednesday Dec 19<sup>th</sup>  
strong breeze from S.E. steering S.W. &  
steering to S.W. to E.S. the S.W. side of the  
Island at daylight the point bore W.S.W. & the  
N.E. point bore N.E. dist 40 miles tack ship  
to S.W. morn'nd winds middle & better strange  
winds at 4 pm tack ship to E.S. at noon Lat 16 15'  
the Island bore W.S.W. & W.S.W. dist 11 miles
