 steering W. at right shortland sail & moved
 south with short sail fine pleasant weather
 middle ground & bottom with Rain at cedar shoals
 7th saw Killers & Comperis out about Lat 18° 59'
 Longt 30 10

Remarks on board Sunday Dec 31st
 strange winds from E. & steering W. at
 4 pm saw 1 w sail to the S. W. at 5 pm another
 to the S. W. at 6 pm took ship to E. S. shortland
 sail wind move inward mid market better
 part strange winds & rough sea saw nothing Lat 18° 50'
 Longt 31 19

Remarks on Board Monday January 1st 1866
 heavy hours begins with strange winds from E.
 steering W. at 4 pm saw pinback & whales at 6 pm
 more inward fine pleasant weather middle better
 part much the same saw nothing Lat 18° 30'
 Longt 33 00

Remarks on board Tuesday Jan 11th
 light wind from S. E. to E. steering W. at 2 pm on a
 wind ran to sail & bark and the anchor hauled, &
 at night no light winds fine pleasant weather
 middle never light winds from South bottom inward wind,
 from S. E. W. & S. steering on arrival at W. to W. W. W.
 with all sail saw nothing fine pleasant
 weather Lat 18° 11'
 Longt 34 02

Remarks on board Wednesday Jan 11th 1866
 winds from S. E. to S. W. & light steering on a wind to
 W. & S. with all sail fine & pleasant weather
 middle never better strange winds took in light sails
 at 4 pm on sail steering south sent a Boat on board
 from tobacco get some while taking the Boat up
 11th saw a hooking got the Taked boat Jackson
 was forward for 11th 11th saw on end then I saw
 to. held on hit he got red Jackson that 8 Regue
 went do nothing then spoke it so all could hear
 I called him off & said to him what did you
 make that remark he denied a part of the
 remark I said to him 11th 11th is my first
 officer and you I know it & don't you make any
 such remarks about him while you are on
 board this vessel he made no reply and started
 forward I called to him again so you & what I say to
 you yes I hear you well you be careful don't do it
 - or again & no reply I see I am that Jackson is
 not good to be on board a Whaler with a Green crew
 I should be protest a guest the other Jackson 11th 11th
 says he wishes him out of vessel he said he belong
 westward have better luck if he Jackson reach
 out of the vessel he is not good now here
 the Bridge clear for a good bound to Rio
 Lat 17° 43' S
 Longt 35 25

 strange winds from E. steering on a wind to S. E. W. & S. W.
 with light sails in mid & spoke long
 bound to Rio middle parts strange winds from S. E. at 4 pm
 took ship to S. W. & sail in the one ship bound
 S. W. the others bound south a heavy sea on
 saw 2 sail all bound south but 1 Lat 18° 35' S
 Longt 35 07
