 at 2 pm anchored in 9 fathoms water at 3 the
 boat went on shore at 4 came on board took out
 and bitter Cash here worked 10 ships & brought out
 on men in the cutter Kades pleasant weather at
 7 am received the vessel at 9 took up anchor
 and were more in shore & anchored in 5 fathoms of
 water at 10 boat went on shore employed in
 fitting water tank at

Remarks on board Thursday Jan 18-1866
 fine pleasant weather the boat on shore at 3 came
 on board with duck, wine & purpkins & other
 things at 5 the boat went on shore at 6 came
 on board set anchor watch at 8 the water boat
 brought 16 Cash of water a large side commenced
 taking it on board and stowing it below at
 10 am finished taking it on board at 11 Jackson
 went on shore

Remarks on board Friday Jan 19-1866
 at 4 am stevedore went on at 3 the boat went on shore
 at 6 the boat came on board with things from
 the shore set anchor watch fine pleasant weather
 between 10 pm & 2 am the harbor boat & 7 am
 left the vessel Brecken wharfteen & 10 am
 Reicht a boatteenen Parker Braden Pass Delumbra
 Moslen Ferry Passa Bruckeyr Anborne Menten
 on a sea Leanne Porlaques at 9 am the boat went
