Thursday 7

This day commenced With light Winds and fine Weather at 2 P.M. the captain went on shore light sail laying off and on the Island at 6 P.M. stood off for the night the Captain on shore the middle and latter part the Wind and Weather much the same
so ends these 24 hours

This day commenced With light Winds from the S.W. steering by the Wind to the West the middle and latter part the Wind and Weather much the same so ends these 24 hours

Saturday 9

This day commenced With strong Winds from the S.W. and rain at 2 P.M. the Captain came on board squarred the yards and stood to sea the middle and latter part light Winds and rain so ends these 24 hours

This day commenced With light Winds from the N.W. steering by the Wind South at 6 tacked ship to the West the Wind light light the Island of Saint George and peak pike and treasure in sight the middle and latter part strong Winds from the N.W. steering by the Wind so ends these 24 hours
