No 51 This day commenced with a moderate breeze from the E. by S. steering S.W. by S the middle and latter part the wind and weather much the same so ends these 24 hours

No 55 This day commenced with strong trades at 4 P.M. the Captain came off squared the yards steering S.W. by S the middle and latter part strong trades took in the light sails the so ends these 24 hours
