so ends these 24 hours

so ends these 24 hours

..... This day commenced with light
s.e. Winds from the South steering
by the Wind S.W. the middle and
latter part the Wind and Weather
much the same so ends these 24 hours

..... This day commenced with light trades
s.e. and fine weather at 5 PM tacked ship
to the S.W. by the Wind the middle
and latter part the Winds light and
fine weather so ends these 24 hours
