..... This day commenced with strong
No 92 SE trades steering NW at sundown
took in sail and heaved to the wind
NW the middle and latter part the
wind and weather much the same
so ends these 24 hours Lat 32.54 S
Long 39.11 W

More 1854 Wednesday 1

..... This day commenced with light
No 93 winds from the NW at sundown
took in sail heading to the south
the middle and latter part the wind
and weather much the same
so ends these 24 hours Lat 23.54 S
Long 39.11 W

Thursday 2

..... This day commenced with strong
No 94 wind from the ESE steering NW
one brig in sight steering the same
the middle and latter part the
wind and weather much the same
so ends these 24 hours Lat 24.24 S
Long 40.51 W

Friday 3

..... This day commenced with light
No 95 winds and fine weather steering NW
2 sail in sight steering the same
the middle and latter part the wind
blowing fresh from the NW steering
NW so ends these 24 hours Lat 26.52 S

..... This day commenced with a moderate
No 96 gale from the NW steering NW at 4
P.M. took in the light sails and furled
the mainsail the middle and latter
part the wind from the NW steering
by the wind NW so ends these 24 hours
Lat 28.51 S
Long 49.04 W

Sunday 5

..... This day commenced with strong
No 97 winds from NW steering by the wind
NW at 4 the wind blowing a moderate
gale from NW took in sail to
double reefed topsails the middle
and latter part the wind light and
fine weather so ends these 24 hours
Lat 29.18 S
Long 43.13 W
