

Remarks on Board Margus
November 1854

Monday 6

..... This day commenced with light
Ab 58 Winds and fine weather at 3 PM
the wind hauled to the E by S
steering N by W the middle and
latter part the wind blowing
strong from the N so ends
these 24 hours do observations

Tuesday 7

..... This day commenced with a moderate
Ab 39 gale from the North steering
N by S at 3 PM double reaped
the topsail the weather thick and
raining at 4 PM last reaped the
fore topsail at 5 PM the wind hauled
to the S by W the latter part it blowing
a gale so ends these 24 hours

Wednesday 8

..... This day commenced with a moderate
Ab 500 gale from the N by E at 4 PM
tacked ship to the N by W the middle
and latter part the wind blowing
more moderate so ends these 24 hours

Thursday 9

..... This day commenced with light winds
Ab 101 from the N by E steering by the wind N by E
3 sail in sight the middle and latter
part the wind and weather much
the same so ends these 24 hours

..... This day commenced with light winds
Ab 102 and fine weather the wind from the
N by E steering by the wind to the N by W
the middle and latter part the wind
and weather much the same so
ends these 24 hours

..... This day commenced with a
Ab 103 moderate breeze from the E by S
steering N by E the middle and latter
part the wind from the N steering
N so ends these 24 hours

Sunday 12

..... This day commenced with strong winds
Ab 104 and fine weather the wind from the N
steering N by W saw plenty of finbacks
the middle and latter part the wind
and weather much the same
so ends these 24 hours

Monday 13

..... This day commenced with light
Ab 105 winds from the N by E steering N by E
the weather thick and raining
the middle and latter part the wind
and weather much the same
so ends these 24 hours
