This day one Watch on liberty got one

and latter part one Watch on shore
so ends

Friday 23

This day one Watch on liberty
the latter part the same so ends

Saturday 24

This day one Watch on liberty
got off potatoes and onions the latter
part one Watch on shore so ends

Sunday 25

This day one Watch on liberty
the latter part the same so ends

Monday 26

This day one Watch on liberty
the latter part the same so ends

Tuesday 27

This day came with fine weather one
Watch on liberty the latter part the
same so ends these 24 hours

Wednesday 28

This day came with fine weather the
liberty stopped all hands on board
so ends these 24 hours

Thursday 1st March 1844

This day came with fine weather
at 4 P.M. took our anchor and put
to sea steering N.W. the middle and
latter part light winds and fine weather
steering N.W. so ends these 24 hours

Friday 2nd March 1844

This day commenced with light winds
and fine weather at 2 P.M. toward after
a hump back Whirl the middle and
latter part light winds and fine weather
so ends these 24 hours

Saturday 3rd

This day came with fine weather
steering N.W. saw black fish the
middle and latter part light winds
and fine weather steering the same
so ends these 24 hours
