No 291 This day commenced with light wind and fine weather standing on different tacks the wind N.E. the middle and latter part much the same so ends these 24 hours

..... Tuesday 31 Lat 22° 29' N Long 88° 46' W

No 292 This day commenced with light wind and fine weather the wind standing on different tacks at 10 AM saw Whales going quick to leeward so ends these 24 hours

..... Wednesday 1 Lat 22° 59' N Long 88° 10' W

No 293 This day commenced with strong wind from the S.W. standing on different tacks the middle and latter part the same so ends these 24 hours

..... Thursday 2 Lat 21° 56' N Long 88° 12' W

No 294 This day commenced with strong wind from the S.W. standing on different tacks at sundown took in sail to double reefed topsail the weather thick standing by the wind West the latter part the wind strong from the S.W. all hands employed in stowing down sail so ends these 24 hours

Lat 21° 52' N Long 88° 16' W

Friday 4

No 295 This day commenced with strong wind from the S.W. standing on different tacks at 4 PM finished stowing down the middle and latter part the wind and weather much the same so ends these 24 hours

..... Saturday 5

No 296 This day commenced with light wind from the S.W. steering N.W. at sundown fluffed to the wind and took in sail laying with the mainyard aback at 6 AM laid all sail steering by the wind so ends these 24 hours

..... Sunday 6 Lat 21° 22' N Long

No 297 This day commenced with strong wind from the S.W. at 4 PM kept off - all the middle and latter part the wind fresh from the S.W. steering N.W. so ends these 24 hours

..... Monday 7 Lat 21° 22' N Long 89° 22' W

No 298 This day commenced with strong wind from the S.W. steering N.W. at sundown took in the light sails the middle and latter part the wind strong from the S.W. standing on different tacks so ends these 24 hours
