May 11th
..... Sunday 3

No 280 This day commenced with strong wind from the N by E steering E at midday took in sail to double reefed topsails the middle part raising the latter part strong winds from the N by E standing on different tacks so ends these 24 hours

..... Wednesday 5

No 281 This day commenced with strong winds from the N by E and fine weather standing to the E by N the middle and latter part the wind and weather much the same steering E by N so ends this day

Lat 23° 00' N
Long 82° 11' W

..... Thursday 6

No 282 This day commenced with light winds and fine weather steering E by N the middle and latter part standing on different tacks so ends

Lat 21° 00' N

..... Friday 7

No 283 This day commenced with light winds from N by E steering by the wind E by N the middle and latter part the wind light so ends

Lat 12° 00' N
Long 83° 36' W

Barque Cacholat at Sea

May 12th
..... Saturday 12

No 284 This day commenced with light winds and fine weather the wind from N by E steering E by N the middle and latter part steering by the wind E by N so ends these 24 hours

Lat 00° 00' N
Long 82° 13' W

..... Sunday 13

No 285 This day commenced with light winds from the N by E steering E by N the wind and weather much the same so ends these 24 hours

Lat 00° 00' N
Long 80° 30' W

..... Monday 14

No 286 This commenced with light winds from N by E steering E by N at 4 PM the wind hauled to the W the middle and latter part the wind from the N by E so ends these 24 hours

Lat 13° 00' N
Long 79° 36' W

..... Tuesday 15

This day commenced with light winds and fine weather at 2 PM the wind hauled to the N by E steering by the wind X the main land in sight distant 13 miles banded in for Wood and Water the latter part at 9 the captain took a boat and went in so ends these 24 hours at 11 PM let go anchor off the town in 4 fathoms water
