Friday ¹⁸

No 290 This day commenced with fine weather all hands employed in stowing water had a little mess with one of the boat cheerers for giving me cause I pinched his neck for him and he was lucky that he did not get more of it the latter part got off a raft of water and sent a raft on shore so ends this day

..... Saturday ¹⁹

No 291 This day commenced with light winds and rain the latter part got off a raft of water and stowed it down so ends this day

..... Sunday ²⁰

No 292 This day commenced with strong winds and fine weather the middle and latter part raining so ends these 24 hours

..... Monday ²¹

No 293 This day commenced with strong winds and fine weather nothing doing on board the latter part got off 8 boat loads of wood so ends these 24 hours

..... Tuesday ²²

No 294 This day commenced with strong winds and fine weather the men on board employed in stowing away wood at 10 AM took our anchor and stood to sea so ends

Wednesday ²³

This day commenced with light winds and fine weather steer by the wind N.W. the middle and latter part the wind light from the N.W. by steering by the wind N by 21° so ends these 24 hours
