Sunday²³

This day commenced with light winds and fine weather standing on different tacks to the south Harbor distant 20 miles the middle and latter part standing on different tacks the wind light and fine weather and in sight so ends these 24 hours

This day commenced with light winds and fine weather standing on different tacks off the sea bay 3 ships in sight 2 of them a gaining the latter part saw 4 ships a sailing so ends these 24 hours

Sat 0025

Tuesday²⁵

This day commenced with strong winds from the N.W. standing off shore at 6 P.M. spoke the Barge Malha Senas of New Bedford a sailing a 20 barrel Mchail the middle and latter part the wind and weather much the same so ends these 24 hours

Sat 0026

Cachalot, N.W. off the Galapagos Islands

Wednesday²⁶

This day commenced with light winds and fine weather being off and on the sea bay the middle and latter part the wind and weather much the same so ends these 24 hours Sat 0027

Thursday²⁷

This day commenced with light winds and fine weather gaining with the ship Worthington and the Barge Harris of New Bedford the middle and latter part the wind light and fine weather so ends these 24 hours

Friday²⁸

This day commenced with light winds and fine weather the wind from the N.W. standing on different tacks off the island of Harbor so ends these 24 hours Sat 0028

Saturday²⁹

This day commenced with light winds and fine weather the rock of disorder in sight and 4 sail in sight an over weather beam the middle and latter part steering S.W. the wind S.W. Menanous Island in sight an over Starboard beam distant 20 miles
