1844 July Wednesday 25th

This day came with strong
winds from the N.W. steering
E under all sail the middle
and latter part the wind and
weather much the same so ends

This day came with light
moderate winds from the N.W.
steering E and the middle
and latter part the wind and
weather much the same so ends

Friday 27th

This day came with light winds
from the N.W. steering E at sundown
shortened sail to middle and latter
part the wind and weather the
same so ends this day

Saturday 28th

This day commenced with light
moderate winds from the N.W.
at 3 P.M. hauled up the wind to
the S.E. at sundown took in the
light sails the middle and latter
part the wind and weather the
same so ends this day
No observations

1844 July Sunday 29th Borque Cachalot at Sea

This day commenced with strong
winds from the N.W. at 1 P.M. tacked
ship to the S.E. at sundown took
in the light sails the middle and
latter part fine weather so ends

Monday 30th

This day commenced with light
winds and fine weather the wind
from the N.W. steering by the
wind S.E. the wind and weather
the latter part much the same
so ends these 24 hours

winds and weather much the same
at 1 P.M. tacked ship to the S.W. by N
the wind N.W. the middle and
