

1855 Remarks on Board
Aug Thursday 16

This day Come with light winds
and fine weather the wind from
the S.W. standing on different
backs & sail in sight at 5 PM
lowered after black fish got near
the middle part strong wind and
thick and rainy the latter part fine
weather steering by the wind E by S
so ends this day

Friday 17 Lat 20 54 N
Long 82 31 W

Says No 230 This day Come with light
winds from the S and fine weather
steering one sail in sight ahead
at sundown took in the light sails
the middle and latter part the wind
much the same so ends this day

Saturday 18

This day Come with light winds
from the N.W. and fine weather
steering West at sundown took in
the light sails and hauled up the
cores and luffed to the wind
the middle and latter part steering
the same so ends this day

Lat 20 54 N

Bargue Cachalot of N.B.
Sunday 19

This day Come with light
winds and fine weather steering
E at sundown took in the light
sails and tacked ship to the
W by S the latter part saw whails
lowered and chased them till
sundown and then resumed

Monday 20

This day Come with light winds
from the N.W. at sundown returned
on board without success steering
E by S at 11 AM saw a large whail
lowered and the Starboard Boat
struck and stove the back and
then went on board and got the gun
and shot in him and then he started
off cut from him and let him go
so ends these 24 hours

Tuesday 21

Lat 20 54 N
Long 82 40 W

This day Come with light winds
from the N.W. at 4 PM picked up
the Boat and took her on deck
the middle and latter part
raining so ends these 24 hours
