Aug Tuesday 28

This day come with light winds from the N.W. steering by the wind to the middle part the wind and weather much the same at 8 AM saw the land on our Starboard now distant 30 miles so ends there 24 hours

Wednesday 29

This day come with light light winds from the N.W. steering by the wind at sundown hauled a back off Tecumseh at 9 AM let go anchor in 4 fathoms of water and turned to stowing down oil so ends this day

Thursday 30

This day come with light winds and fine weather all hands employed in stowing oil at 6 PM finished stowing the middle part fine weather the latter part all hands employed in stowing up shoes for water so ends this day

Friday 31

This day come with fine weather got off 40 Barrels of water at 10 AM took our anchor to look for a better place to get water so ends this day

Sep Saturday 1

This day come with light winds and fine weather at 12 PM spoke the Barque Joseph Bragden of S.B. bound into Comacina the middle part fine weather at 9 AM sent two Boats on shore so ends this day

Sunday 2

This day come with fine weather at sundown the Boats returned on board at 9 AM sent in 2 Boats the ship laying off and on so ends this day

Monday 3

This day come with strong winds from the N.W. at 4 PM the Boats returned on board the Capt on shore at 8 AM sent in 2 Boats so ends this day

Tuesday 4

This day come with light winds from the N.W. at 4 PM the Boats returned on board and stood to sea one man by the name of Mike Bagen took log bail and left the middle and latter part the winds strong from the N.W. standing on different tacks working up the coast so ends this day
