1844 Tuesday²

This day came with light winds from the S.W. steering S.E. at 6 AM hauled the chains and got the anchors off the bow at 6 the port of stumps distant 24 miles the middle and latter part calm so ends this day

Wednesday³

This day came with light winds from the N.W. at sundown saw the shipping lag at anchor distant from the anchorage 10 miles steering S.W. & going at the rate of one hour mile and hour at 10 PM let go our anchor in 7 fathoms of water so ends these 24 hours

Thursday⁴

This day came with fine weather all hands employed in washing ship and other jobs about ship so ends these 24 hours

Friday⁵

This day got one raft off Cashes on shore for water the latter part got off a raft of water so ends this day

Saturday⁶

This day came with fine weather got all hands employed in stowing down water the latter part the same so ends this day

Sunday⁷

This day came with fine weather nothing doing on board the latter part stowing down water so ends this day

Monday⁸

This day came with fine weather went in a raft for water the latter part the same so ends this day

Tuesday⁹

This day came with fine weather employed in getting off wood the latter part the same so ends

Wednesday¹⁰

This day came with fine weather employed in getting off wood the latter part finished so ends this day
