 at Cape Blanco to Boat and on
 board the ship Catalpa to take home
 on freight all hands employed
 in breaking out and the latter
 part all hands employed in Boasting
 and on board the ship Catalpa
 so ends these 24 hours

Now March ²⁵ 1846
 leaving in Port
 left on the 16 of April 1846

Remarks on Board Bangal Sea View
 Thursday ¹⁸

This day came with light winds
 from the SW at 1 PM took our anchor
 and stood to sea at 6 PM the wind
 hauled to the NW tacked ship to
 the NW the middle and latter part
 the wind strong and thick weather
 so ends these 24 hours
 Sat 39.26

Friday ¹⁹

This day came with light
 winds from the WNW standing by
 the wind NW the middle and
 latter part the wind fresh from
 the S standing by the wind NW
 so ends these 24 hours
 Sat 39.13

Saturday ²⁰
 This day came with moderate
 winds from the S standing by
 the wind S by W at 6 PM took in
 the light sails
