Sunday 25th
 This day came with light winds
 and fine weather. All hands
 employed in the same duty
 at 2 PM finished beating oil on
 board the ship Calapa 258 barrels of
 sperm and 40 bundles of beam at 4 PM
 took our anchor and stood to sea
 bound to Saito the middle and latter
 part standing on different tacks
 the wind SE so ends these 24 hours
 Set 425

Monday 26th
 This day came with fine weather
 the wind light from the SE
 standing by the wind SE at
 sundown Saita head in sight
 bearing SE distant 15 miles
 at 11 PM hauled aback off the
 port and the captain took a boat
 and went in made sail and stood
 to sea for 2 days to black fish
 it till the captain got done with
 his business on shore so ends this day

Barque Barque Sea Breeze

Tuesday 27th
 This day came with strong SE trades
 standing off shore at 6 PM tacked
 ship in shape at 8 tacked ship
 off shore heading by the wind SE
 the SE by E the land distant 20 miles
 the middle and latter part standing
 on different tacks so ends

Wednesday 28th

This day came with light
 winds from the E, S, E standing
 on different tacks at 3 PM lowered
 down and got 2 black fish
 at 2 PM tacked ship in shape
 standing by the wind E the wind
 SE by E at 11 PM hauled a back
 of the boat of Saita and sent
 in a boat skiped a third water
 the Bunker and one seaman
 by the name of George Bresham
 so ends these 24 hours
