the latter part the same so ends this day

Thursday 31

This day comes with fine weather the
carpenters to work on board 13 of them
the middle part raining the latter part
fine weather so ends this day

Friday 1 January 1848

This day comes with fine weather
the carpenters not to work on board today
the latter part the carpenters at work on
board the weather thick and rainy so ends

Saturday 2

This day comes with rainy weather
nothing doing on board the carpenters
left on account of the rain all hands
on board employed in sundry jobs
so ends this day

Sunday 3

This day comes with fine weather
all hands employed in netting holes and
mashing off decks the latter part fine
weather so ends this day

Monday 4

This day comes with fine weather
all hands employed in sundry jobs about
ship the carpenters to work on board
the latter part fine weather so ends this day

Tuesday 5

This day comes with fine weather 23 carpenters
to work on board at sun down got the
foremast a long side the latter part steep
the foremast and stowed off the fore halyard on one
side so ends this day

Wednesday 6

This day comes with fine weather all hands
employed in stowing off the fore halyard
24 carpenters to work on the ship
the latter part not much doing on board.
