Friday ^{the} 14th
 This day came with strong
 winds from the NW steering
 E by S at 1 Bell set whole topsails
 about 5 in the middle and latter part
 the wind and weather much the
 same so ends these 24 hours

Saturday ^{the} 15th

This day came with strong winds
 from the S steering E by S by the
 wind the middle and latter part
 the wind light from the S by E
 standing by the wind E by S so ends

Lat 33.05 N
 Long 80.55 W

Sunday ^{the} 16th

This day came with light winds
 from the S by E standing by the wind
 E by S at 2 Bell saw the Island of
 Massapuca distant 20 miles bearing
 S by E the middle and latter part
 the wind light from the S by E
 so ends these 24 hours

Monday ^{the} 17th

This day came with light light
 winds from the S by N steering S by E
 the Island of Massapuca in sight
 bearing S by N distant 24 miles
 the middle part strong winds from the
 S by N at day light saw the Island
 Juan Fernandez on Starboard
 low distant 24 miles so ends this day

Barque Sea Breeze

Tuesday ^{the} 18th
 This day came with strong winds
 from the NW steering E by S
 the watch employed in bending a new
 for topsail and foresail the wind strong
 from the NW and the weather thick
 and raining the middle and latter part
 the wind strong from the NW so ends

Wednesday 19

This day came with strong winds
 from the NW steering E by S half S
 at 3 Bell took in the light
 sails the middle and latter part
 steering E by S half S at 6 still
 saw the land distant 30 miles
 bearing E so ends these 24 hours

Thursday ^{the} 20th

This day came with strong
 winds from the NW steering
 E by S for halchana Port
 at 4 Bell let go our anchor in
 4 fathoms of water so sail laying
 in this Port and one of them an
 pier that was the George Washington
 of New Bedford she has set an
 pier by the crew two days before
 to this the latter part all hands
 employed in stowing the oil over between
 decks so ends this day
