the latter part employed in stowing
off the between decks
so ends these 24 hours

Saturday 22nd
This day came with fine weather
not much doing on board
the latter part the same
so ends these 24 hours

Sunday 23rd
This day came with fine weather
not much doing on board
& sail coming in to anchor

Arrived March 26th 1856
Left Malabano April 16th 1856
for the Port of New Bedford
Barque Sea Breeze

March 20th 1856
Received two letters
from my wife &
dated January 20 and 26
and are dated October
21 1856
Close for the rats
and mice and all other
varments of the
ship

April 1856

Thursday 17th
This day came with fine weather
at 1 P.M. took air anchor and
stood to sea at 6 P.M. the wind hauled
to the NW tacked ship to the NW
the middle and latter part the wind
strong so ends these 24 hours
Lat 34.26 N

Friday 18th
This day came with fine weather
the wind from the NW standing by
the wind S.W. by W the middle and
latter part the wind and weather
such the same so ends
Lat 34.13 N

Saturday 19th
This day came with strong wind
from the S standing by the wind
S.W. by W at 6 P.M. took in the light
sails the middle and latter part the
wind and weather the same so ends
these 24 hours
Lat 34.26 N
Long 80.30 W

Sunday 20th
This day came with strong winds
and fine weather the wind from
the S steering by the wind N.W.
the middle and latter part standing
on different tacks so ends
Lat 34.36 N
