Monday 21st
This day came with strong winds from the S.W. standing by the wind S.E. at 8 o'clock took in the light sails at 6 o'clock the wind blowing S. and thick weather double reefed the topsails at 4 in the morning wore ship to the S.W. and took in the foretop sail the latter part the wind strong and heavy squall from the S.E. so ends this day

Tuesday 22nd
This day came with a moderate gale from the S.E. and heavy squall standing by the wind S.W. under short sail the middle part the wind more moderate at daylight set whole topsails so ends this day

This day came with strong winds from the S. at 1 o'clock tacked ship to the E.N.E. at 5 o'clock saw a ship steering N.W. the middle and latter part the wind and weather the same so ends this day

This day came with strong winds from the S.W. standing by the wind S.E. at 4 o'clock took in double reefed the topsails the middle and latter part the wind light from the S.W. standing by the wind S.E. so ends
