Saturday 10

This day came with strong winds from the N.W. at 1 P.M. double reefed the topsails steering N.E. at 4 P.M. the wind hauled to the N. it blowing strong the middle and latter part the wind light from the N.W. so ends these 24 hours

Sunday 11

Lat 43.41 S

Long 47.53 W

This day came with light winds from the N.W. at 1 P.M. the lower standing sail and top guller sail now going along with a nice little breeze the middle and latter part the wind and weather the same so ends this day

Monday 12

This day came with light winds from the N.W. steering N.E. at 1 P.M. under all sail the middle and latter part strong winds from the S.E. steering across N.E. by N so ends these 24 hours

No observation

This day came with strong winds from the S.E. steering a course N.E. by E at 1 P.M. took in the light sails at 4 P.M. the wind more moderate at the main top guller sail the middle and latter part the wind and weather much the same so ends these 24 hours

Lat 36.49 S

Tuesday 13

This day came with strong winds from the S.E. standing by the wind at under all sail at 10 at night the wind blowing heavy from the E. Close reefed the topsail and took in the chain sail the latter part it blowing a heavy gale so ends

Wednesday 14

This day came with a heavy gale from the E. at 3 P.M. took in the fore topsail and foresail the ship now laying to the wind under short sail the middle and latter part it blowing a heavy gale laying by the wind E. by S so ends this day
