

June 1856 Remarks on

Thursday 26

This day came with fine weather the wind light from the S steering about at 4 Bell spoke the schooner Howard of Plymouth 4 days from Boston bound to Havana the middle and latter part the wind light from the S steering about so ends this day

Friday 27

This day came with moderate winds from the S steering about the middle and latter part the wind and weather much the same so ends these 24 hours

Saturday 28

This day came with strong winds from the S steering about the weather thick at 3 Bell tacked ship to the N by all standing by the wind the wind about at the latter part the wind light from the ESE steering about so ends this day

Board the Barque Sea Breeze

Sunday 29

This day came with light airs from the S steering about and fine weather and sail in sight the middle and latter part strong winds from WSW steering about the weather thick and foggy so ends this day

Lat 39.54 N
Long 71.06 W

Monday 30

June 1856

This day came with strong winds from the WSW steering about at 4 Bell saw the land the back side of Long Island kept at ESE at 6 Bell morning light distant 15 miles bearing WSE saw several sail steering ESE

End of Voyage

Tuesday 1

This day comes with light winds from ESE standing by the wind to the SSE at 2 the weather squally till in the light sails at daylight made all sail at 4 tacked ship to the N by all the latter part the wind and weather the same so ends these 24 hours
