tacks at 8 A.M. 12 sail in sight the ship
under all sail now and then a rain squall
the watch employed sundae jobs the latter
part the wind and weather the same so ends.

Saturday 14

This day comes with fine weather at 1 P.M.
kept off for the Barque Bell at 4 hauled
aback and the Capt came on board and
we had a gun the middle and latter part
standing to the N.W. so ends this day.
