

North Pacific Ocean
Saturday 13 1848

This day comes with light winds from the E steering by the wind S.E. at sundown the Island of Saint John distant 15 miles bearing S.E. and the Island of Orison bearing N.W. distant 25 miles the middle and latter part light airs and variable so ends this day

Sunday 14

This day comes with light winds and fine weather the wind light from all parts the compass at sundown the wind light from the N.W. steering by the wind S.E. the weather thick and raining the middle and latter part light winds from the S.E. steering S.E. by E so ends these 24 hours

Monday 15

This day comes with light airs from S.E. and variable at 5 P.M. the Island of Orison distant 35 miles bearing N.E. at 6 P.M. one of the men by the name of George Shannon was ordered by the fourth mate Mr. Cameron to haul up home the fore topgallant sheet with the rest of the watch and he went down in the fore castle and he was ordered on deck and he said he should not till he had got his supper but finally he came on deck and Mr. Cameron was a going to talk him by the hat as he was coming up and he struck the officer in the face and he bore him down and struck him several times and the captain put him in irons at the time this happened

the after guard was down to supper at 9 in the evening let him out of irons the middle part heavy rain the latter part of this day light airs and wind calms so ends this day

Tuesday 16

This day comes with light airs from the S.E. steering by the wind on different tacks at sundown calms took in the light sails and hauled up the canvas the weather thick and heavy expecting to have rain the middle and latter part raining the wind light and variable steering on different tacks so ends

Wednesday 17

This day comes with light airs and raining the wind all round the compass but lighter there is the middle and latter part of this day much the same so ends this day

Thursday 18

This day comes with light winds from the N.W. steering S.E. the middle and latter part strong winds from the South steering S.E. by E at 8 P.M. saw Hadley's Island bearing E.S.E. distant 15 miles the weather thick and raining so ends

Friday 19

This day comes with light winds from S.W. steering S.E. at sundown Hadley's Island bearing E by S distant 20 miles the middle and latter part calms and raining so ends this day
