

Bark Sea Breeze

Nov 26 1858

Ship Sea Breeze Saw standing
on different tacks in the latitude
5.15 N Long 154 E standing on different
tacks the Capt William Johnson which
was put in irons for setting fire to
the ship and was kept in a house
on the quarter deck at 11 AM the schooner
came out of the house and jumped over board
and was seen no more toward a boat
and used all exertions to save him
but was in vain

Sunday 28 Cruising in Bouha Bay

This day comes with light winds from
the S.W. standing on different tacks at sundown
took in the light sails and furled the mainsail
now standing by the wind to the S.W. under
short sail the Barque Joseph Butler is sight
the middle part strong winds from west and equally
the latter part calm and rainy so ends this day

Monday 29 Cruising in Bouha Bay

This day commences with a calm the weather
thick and rainy the middle and latter part the
wind light the weather much the same standing
on different tacks so ends this day

Tuesday 30 Bouha Bay

This day comes with light air
from the S.E. standing by the wind
to the E the middle part standing by the wind
at daylight the wind light from S.E. at daylight
the wind from the S.W. steering a course S.E.
so ends these 30 hours

Wednesday 1st 1858 Bouha Bay

This day commences with light winds
from the E.S.E. steering S.E. the weather
thick and rainy the middle part calm
the latter part the wind light from S.W.
steering S.E. 3 canoes along side with skull
so ends this day
