this 24 hours begins with a fine breeze & fine weather
gaming with the ship's crew of martenicht catch cotton at 6
PM shortened sail at 8 PM catch cotton went home he
was out 26 months & had 1700 hundred barrels
latter part of the day light winds & pleasant weather
at 8 AM commenced gaming with the ship's crew
went on board of the ship & mister Ramsel came on board
of our ship. Lat in by obs 22.32 South

119 Remarks on board Saturday February 7. 1835

this 24 hours begins with light winds & pleasant weather gaming
with the ship's crew of martenicht catch cotton at 8 PM mister
Ramsel went on board of the ship at 9 AM capt Crowell came on
board of the ship & heaved foreward the main yard & stood
to the westward. middle & latter part of the day light winds &
pleasant weather at 5 AM made all necessary sail & steered to
the NW westward and the ship stood to the westward at 8 AM
left side of her. Lat in by obs 21.38 South - 3 days 3

120 Remarks on board Sunday February 8. 1835

this 24 hours begins with a light breeze & pleasant weather steering
to the NW westward employed in ships duty at sunset shortened
sail & kept her going to the north. latter part of the day
light winds & pleasant weather under all necessary sail
steering to the north. Lat in by obs 20.19 South

121 Remarks on board Monday February 9. 1835

this day commences with a light breeze & pleasant weather
steering to the north at sunset furled topgallant sails at 5 AM
made all necessary sail & steered to the NW eastward
employed in various kinds of work about the ship
commenced mending the four topsail. Lat in by obs 19.30 South

122 Remarks on board Tuesday February 10. 1835

this 24 hours begins with a light breeze & pleasant weather
steering to the NW at 1 PM saw a moshradite brig
standing to the eastward watch employed in ships duty at
sunset furled mainsail & gills & heeled to the westward latter
part of the day light breeze & pleasant weather employed in
ships duty nothing in sight remarkable Lat in by obs 18.21 South

123 Remarks on board Wednesday February 11. 1835

this day commences with light breeze & calm & pleasant
weather at 4 PM finished mending the four topsail at
sunset furled topgallant sails at 5 AM made all sail
latter part of the day pleasant weather employed in ships
duty nothing in sight remarkable Lat in by obs 17.20 South

124 Remarks on board Thursday February 12. 1835

this 24 hours begins with pleasant weather under all
sail steering to the NW eastward saw a plenty of black
fish broke out the bow hole after water at sunset
furled topgallant sails at 5 AM made all sail & steered NW
latter part of the day fine breeze & pleasant weather
employed in ships duty Lat in by obs 16.18 South

125 Remarks on board Friday February 13. 1835

this 24 hours begins with pleasant weather under all
sail steering NW we were in sight of the land saw
a plenty of fin backs whales & black fish at sunset
furled top gall sails at 5 AM made all sail saw
a moshradite brig standing to the eastward latter
part of the day fine breeze & passing down saw some hump
back whales. Lat in by obs 15.19 South
