

222 Remarks on board the ship Cadmus Tuesday May 26th 1835
 this day fine breeze & cloudy weather under all necessary sail steering to the
 N. E. by the wind employed in mending the four top sail at 4 PM
 finished mending it & headed it up in the cask at 5 PM saw two fin back
 whales at sunset reefed the top sails & furled the main sail
 latter part of the day cloudy weather at 5 AM set main sail &
 main top gal sail watch employ. in various kinds of work
 left in by 4.42 North

223 Remarks on Wednesday May 27th 1835
 this day strong breeze & cloudy weather attended with small rain by
 shells watch employ. in various kinds of work about the ship at 6 PM
 furled main top gal sail & main sail steering to the Eastward
 latter part of the day fine breeze from the S. E. & passing clouds under
 all necessary sail steering to the Eastward watch employ. in ships
 duty, so ends this day, left in by 5.04 North

224 Remarks on Thursday May 28th 1835
 this day begins with a fine breeze steering to the Eastward by the wind
 watch employ. in ships duty at sunset furled main top gal sail &
 main sail latter part of the day light breeze & pleasant weather under
 all necessary sail steering to the N. E. watch employ. in setting up
 the four & main rigging at 10 PM tacked ship to the S. E. & westward
 at 11 PM saw a school of Phorm whales lowered 3 boats & got 3
 whales one to the waist boat & two to the larboard boat & killed 2 long
 whales lost them left in by 5.30 North

225 Remarks on Friday May 29th 1835
 this day light breeze & pleasant weather all hands employ. in
 whaling at 4 PM took 3 whales at long line & got ready for cutting
 them in & shortened sail & set short watches for the night at 5 AM
 called all hands & commenced cutting on the whales at 10 AM finished
 cutting them in & made sail & turned to the N. E. with light breeze & pleasant
 weather left in by 5.20 North

226 Cruising on the Western Grouper Saturday May 30th 1835
 this day light breeze & pleasant weather steering to the N. E. all hands
 employed in cutting up junk at 2 PM commenced boiling head at 11
 PM finished the head light sheets & rain by shells
 latter part of the day rainy attended with thunder & lightning at
 11 AM cooled down the works & furled the four & main top sail & jib
 so ends this day left in by 5.10 North

227 Remarks on Sunday May 31st 1835
 this day begins more clear but cloudy at 2 PM commenced boiling the
 wind from the South heading E. S. E. at 1.4 PM commenced raining
 & at 1.55 PM clear finisher boiling & washed off decks & made that
 & stand E. S. E. by the wind fine weather
 left in by 6.06 North

228 Remarks on Monday June 1st 1835
 this day fine breeze & passing clouds under all necessary sail steering
 E. S. E. by the wind from the South at 1 PM saw a large school of
 Phorm whales lowered 3 boats to the starboard boat got fast to a large whale
 & got stern the waist boat & pulled up to him to get fast to the whale turned
 round & came for the boat & eat him up & lost one man the larboard boat
 picked the man up & conveyed them to the ship but the boat & crew saved the
 rest & some other things the starboard & larboard boat pulled after the whales
 we got out of boat from over head & pulled after them we picked up some
 things from the waist boat & came on board & stand for the whales at 4 PM
 lowered 3 boats & got fast to the cable boat & got the whale to shouting blood
 the wounded his line was mangled he lost on his line & parted it & lost the
 whale at sunset came on board & furled main sail & main top gal sail
 & jib & stand after the whales stood short watches
 latter part of the day fine breeze & some cloudy at 5 PM tacked ship to the
 N. E. & made sail employ. in mending the stowen boat coiling lines
 & fitting craft & C left in by 6.21 North

229 Remarks on Tuesday June 2nd 1835
 first part of the day, fine breeze & cloudy weather employ. in mending
 the boat & fitting craft steering to the S. E. at 6 PM furled jib & reefed the
 four top sail had a squall & rain middle &
 latter part of the day rainy by shells & strong breeze watch employ. in
 in washing their clothes left in by 5.15 North
