Three ships begin with fine weather & fine breeze from the SE & steering to the SE by the wind all hands employed in hauling one ship in sight of us at 10 AM but could not get close to him chased him 10 miles from the ship the wind all died away, thick weather & raining by shells one ship in sight of us at 10 AM & in the evening we all got on board & got shipped & stored most watches
 Latter part of the day fine breeze & fine weather at 5 PM called all hands & much laid & commenced washing off decks one ship in sight to the windward of us while washing off decks saw a large whale got breakfast & dinner & 8 boats & got past the last boat & were soon killed him while we were taking the whale at long, here the ship runs off & looks as it was the gong & started to 4 minutes out 20 barrels out & they saw us at 10 PM we got the whale at long, here & commenced cutting on the land to make the day fine weather on 11 PM
