

700 On Board of the Ship Cadmus of Fairbanks William Crowell Master

Remarks on Saturday December 2d, 1880

then 24 hours begins with strong breeze from the N.E. & passing clouds
employed in washing close at 8 AM took 3 fish to the S.W. & saw
at N.E. of our weather beam steering to the S.W. & at 10 AM down
shortened sail middle & latter part of the day fine weather & at fine
breeze under all masting sail steering to the N.E. & the wind
employed on board turned in the harbor & four top mast heads tops
the day ends with fine pleasant weather. Lat in 58° 22' 17" North.

701 Remarks on Sunday December 3d, 1880

then 24 hours begins with fine breeze from the N.E. & pleasant weather steering
to the N.E. by the wind employed in this duty & nothing in sight
at 10 AM down shortens sail as usual middle & latter part of this day
fine breeze & some clouds steering to the South by the wind at 10 AM
saw a boat of whale 5 miles off our lee bow back of her
but saw nothing more was took it to be at her back
Lat in 58° 23' 17" North

702 Remarks on Monday December 4th 1880

then 24 hours begins with fine breeze from the S.W. & passing clouds
steering to the South by the wind at 10 AM down took in sail for the
night latter part of the day strong breeze from the S.W. & cloudy
weather steering to the N.E. at 7 AM on board the four sail & commenced
mending it at 8 AM saw a boat of whale & one found
her to be the same as the day ends with pleasant weather. Lat in 58° 24' 05" North.

703 Remarks on Tuesday December 5th 1880

then 24 hours begins with fine breeze from the S.W. & cloudy weather steering
to the N.E. by the wind employed on board at 5 PM finished mending the
four sail & sent it to the yard at 10 AM down shortens sail & the topside
latter part of the day light winds & some small rain at 8 AM had
up mending & 10 AM went to the lower hole & lower down the boats
& worked the boards on both sides at 11 the wind breeze from the
evening the day ends with light winds & at 10 AM saw a boat on heading to
the Eastward by the wind. Lat in 58° 24' 20" North.

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Remarks on Wednesday December 7th 1880

then 24 hours begins with light winds from the even & foggy weather
by the wind steering to the Eastward & the wind employed on board
at 10 AM down shortens sail & took 3 fish to the S.W.
middle & latter part of this day thick weather & at plenty of rain
attended with some thunder & lightning & light breeze from
the N.E. at 2 AM had the lower & middle topsails at 10
AM had the lower topsail & the day ends with heavy heading
to the N.E. Lat in 58° 25' 00" North

705 Remarks on Thursday December 8th 1880

then 24 hours begins with light breeze from the N.E. & rainy weather
heading to the N.E. at 4 PM had up raining & began to breeze
from the even & thick weather at 7 AM on board the four & lower
topsail & double reefed the main middle part of the day
latter part fine breeze from the N.E. & cloudy much sail & steam
employed on board. Lat in 58° 23' 40" North

706 Remarks on Friday December 9th 1880

then 24 hours begins with fine breeze from the N.E. & passing clouds steering
to the N.E. at 1 PM down shortens sail & on board at 10 AM down took the
four & lower topsails & lay with the main topsail at each
head to the masthead. Latter part of the day light breeze from the
N.E. & some fog at 5 PM made all sail & steamed to the N.E. by
the wind the day ends with employed in washing close. Lat in 58° 24' 18" North

707 Remarks on Saturday December 10th 1880

then 24 hours begins with fine breeze from the N.E. & passing clouds steering
to the N.E. employed in washing at 10 AM down took 3 fish to the
N.E. & shortens sail middle & latter part of this day calm weather
& pleasant employed on board turning in the main top mast tack
steep & other heads & work this day ends with calm. Lat in 58° 24' 07" North
