Remarks on Sunday November 1st 1887

Three 24 hours begins with a fine breeze from the N.W. & squally weather under all sail steering S.W. by W. on board at 8 AM shifted over the stern of sail on the barbed pole & steered East at 8 PM began to rain hauled in the main top gallant steering sail & reeled the main topmast at 10 PM the wind hauled to the South & blew at moderate gale of wind calld all hands & took in all sail but a double reefed main topmast & set four sail & set the four shroul steering 8 PM at 2 PM set a double reef four top sail & turned the red out of the four sail latter part of the day strong breeze from the S.W. & cloudy weather under all misbay sail steering East lat in 2 49.40 South long in 2 52 11 9.50 West

Three 24 hours begins with strong S.W. winds & squally weather under all misbay sail steering East with a latter part of the day strong breeze & heavy squalls at 8 PM set the top mast & lower steering sail at 10 PM the main top gallant & steering sail the day ends with strong breeze under all misbay sail steering East lat in 2 49.58 South long in 2 52 11 18 West

1053 Remarks on Sunday Night 22 1887

Three 24 hours begins with strong breeze from the N.W. & cloudy weather under all sail steering S.W. by W. on board at 7 PM shifted in the lower & main top gallant steering sail at 10 took in the four top mast steering sail latter part of the day strong winds from the N.W. & thick weather under all misbay sail steering S.W. by W. the day ends with moderate gale lat in 2 49 51.00 South long in 2 52 11 00 West

1054 Remarks on Sunday Night 22 1887

Three 24 hours begins with squally weather from the N.W. & thick weather under all misbay sail steering S.W. by W. on board at 7 PM took in the main top gallant sail & double reefed the four top sail at 9 PM the main going under three top sail & four sail smooth & latter part of the day strong winds & squally weather squalls of snow under all misbay sail steering S.W. by W. the day ends with strong winds from the N.W. lat in 2 49 52.28 South long in 2 52 10 00 West

Three 24 hours begins with strong breeze from the N.W. & squally weather under all misbay sail steering S.W. by W. on board at 7 PM shifted in the main top gallant steering sail at 9 PM shifted the lower one at 7 PM shifted in the steering sail the wind hauled to the North at 10 PM shifted the main top gallant sail & reeled the main top sail squally weather at 2 PM shifted the main sail double reefed the main top sail & set reefed the four one shifted the main top mast moderate gale & thick weather the day ends with strong winds from the N.W. & squally weather under all misbay sail steering S.W. by W. lat in 2 49 52.20 South long in 2 52 9.54 West

Three 24 hours begins with strong breeze from the N.W. & squally weather under all misbay sail steering S.W. by W. on board at 7 PM set the main top gallant steering sail at 9 PM shifted the lower one at 7 PM shifted in the steering sail the wind hauled to the North at 10 PM shifted the main top gallant sail & reeled the main top sail squally weather at 2 PM shifted the main sail double reefed the main top sail & set reefed the four one shifted the main top mast moderate gale & thick weather the day ends with strong winds from the N.W. & squally weather under all misbay sail steering S.W. by W. lat in 2 49 52.20 South long in 2 52 9.54 West

1057 Remarks on Sunday Night 22 1887

Three 24 hours begins with strong winds from the N.W. & heavy squalls steering S.W. by W. at 8 PM hauled one reef out of the main top sail & set the main top gallant sail quite moderate with part thick weather & a plenty of snow latter part strong breeze from the N.W. & heavy squalls under all misbay sail steering S.W. by W. at 10 PM reefed the main top sail & shifted the main top gallant sail lat in 2 49 52.40 South long in 2 52 9.43 West

1058 Remarks on Sunday Night 22 1887

Three 24 hours begins strong winds from the N.W. & squally weather steering S.W. by W. at 1 PM double reefed the four top sail at 4 PM shifted the four & main top sails & double reefed the main top sail at 6 PM it blew at heavy gale under double reef main top sail & four sail heavy squalls weather clearing at 8 PM under all misbay sail the day ends with moderate breeze lat in 2 49 52.40 South long in 2 52 9.43 West
