

1077 On Board of the *MS Gudmund* of Fairhaven William Crowell Master  
Remarks on Wednesday Oct 27<sup>th</sup> 1837

Three 24 hours begins with a fine breeze from the Eastward & cloudy weather - Steering on the E watch embayed on board at 4 P.M. under the boom & Mizzen top sails the wind hauled 8 or 9 miles & latter part of the day fine breeze & sailing smooth under all masts - fair steering on E watch embayed in fitting the main & fore rigging the day ends with a fine breeze left in 3 1/2 days 4 1/2 miles  
Longitude 50° 51' 30" West

1078 Remarks on Thursday Oct 28<sup>th</sup> 1837  
Three 24 hours begins with a fine breeze from the ESE & sailing smooth under all masts - fair steering on NE watch embayed in fitting the main & fore rigging at 6 P.M. under the main top gallant sail & reefed the top sails of heavy swell bearing from the NNE middle & latter part of the day strong breeze from the NE & sailing smooth under all masts - fair steering on NE watch embayed on board latter part of 3 1/2 days 5 1/2 miles  
Longitude 50° 11' West

1079 Remarks on Friday Oct 29<sup>th</sup> 1837  
Three 24 hours begins with a fine breeze from the NE & some squally under all masts - fair steering on NE watch embayed on board got out weather - out of the Mizzen at 4 P.M. under the four top mast steering sail at 8 P.M. hauled in the steering sail under the main top gallant sail & reefed the main top sail middle & latter part of the day fine breeze & fine weather - under all sails steering on NE watch embayed in fitting the four top gallant mast the day ends with fine weather left in 3 1/2 days 8 1/2 miles  
Longitude 50° 40' West

1080 Remarks on Saturday Oct 30<sup>th</sup> 1837  
Three 24 hours begins with a fine breeze from the NE & fine weather - steering on NE watch embayed in fitting the four top gallant rigging middle & latter part of the day fine breeze & fine weather - under all sails at 8 P.M. under the Mizzened boat out on the ground at 9 last 8 law at large whale hauled 2 boats in him he was going to quick to the windward but at 10 got on board made all sail & steered on NE watch embayed in fitting the four top gallant rigging the day ends with fine weather left in 3 1/2 days 8 1/2 miles  
Longitude 50° 46' 30" West

1081 Remarks on Sunday Oct 31<sup>st</sup> 1837  
Three 24 hours begins with fine weather & light winds from the NE steering on NE watch embayed on board at 2 P.M. under the four top gallant sail at 10 P.M. under the NE light winds & pleasant weather latter part of the day fine breeze from the NE & sailing smooth at 10 law of this steering on NE watch embayed on board at 11 spoke her it was the bark, Francis & Fairhaven call cocks 78 days from Fairhaven call were on board of her & her deck, & crew her  
left in 3 1/2 days 8 1/2 miles  
Longitude 50° 48' 20" West

1082 Remarks on Monday Oct 31<sup>st</sup> 1837  
Three 24 hours begins with a strong breeze from the NE & sailing smooth under all masts - fair steering on NE watch embayed on board at 11 P.M. under the main top gallant sail & reefed the top sails at 7 under the main top gallant sail & reefed the four top sail at 9 under the main top sail & reefed the main top sail  
latter part of the day strong winds & cloudy weather at 2 P.M. under the main top sail & reefed the day ends with a strong breeze the watch embayed in fitting the rigging left in 3 1/2 days 8 1/2 miles  
Longitude 50° 44' 20" West

1083 Remarks on Tuesday Oct 31<sup>st</sup> 1837  
Three 24 hours begins with a strong breeze from the NE & thick weather & foggy heading to the NE under the main top sail the watch embayed in fitting the rigging at 8 P.M. under the main top sail & reefed the four top sail at 9 under the main top sail at 5 P.M. under the Mizzen the day ends with a strong breeze & thick weather left in 3 1/2 days 8 1/2 miles  
Longitude 50° 44' 30" West

1084 Remarks on Wednesday Oct 1<sup>st</sup> 1837  
Three 24 hours begins with moderate gales from the Eastward & thick weather & sailing heading to the north under the main top sail reefed the four top sail at 9 P.M. began to make sail latter part of the day moderate winds & foggy weather the wind from NE under all sails steering on NE watch embayed in fitting the four top gallant rigging the day ends with moderate weather left in 3 1/2 days 8 1/2 miles  
Longitude 50° 46' 15" West
