

Thursday Sept 13 1872

First part of these 24 hours blowing a gale from the SW ship under close reef main top sail Middle and Latter parts the same at sun down wore ship saw two sails and so ends.

Friday Sept 14

Lat-46.41 First part of these 24 hours strong breezes and fog with rain Middle part moderate made sail Latter part light air and calm at day light wore ship saw two sails. Employed in ship duty and so ends this day.

Saturday Sept 15

Lat-46.22 First part of these 24 hours strong breezes Middle part the same Latter part blowing a gale ship on the port tack heading W by S Broke out water and Reef and Port and so ends.

Sunday Sept 16

Lat-46.20 First part of these 24 hours strong breezes and frequent rain squalls Middle and Latter parts the same ship on the starboard tack heading SE and so ends.

Monday Sept 17

Lat-46.10 Long 25.00 First part of this day light breezes Middle and Latter parts the same about 1 P. M. the Cooper raised a school of whales lowered 4 boats and the Larboard boat struck the whale took the line bent on the waist boat never got up to the whale again about 9 O clock cut and came aboard and so ends.

Tuesday

Sept 18 1872

These 24 hours light breezes and calms saw several sails broke out a cask of tow line saw blackfish and the starboard boat struck one took him in and so ends.

Wednesday

Sept 19

Lat-45.48 Long 25.10 These 24 hours light breezes most of the time about noon the 2^d mate raised a school of whales lowered 4 boats got two one to the starboard and one to the waist boats the larboard darted but did not succeed in getting fast took the whales along side about dark and so ends.

Thursday

Sept 20

These 24 hours blowing a gale at day light commenced to cut got the body of one and let the head go the weather being so bad and so ends.

Friday

Sept 21

These 24 hours strong breezes at day light went to cutting in wearing ship parted fluke chain lowered and took the whale along side again at dark stoped cutting started the try works and so ends.

Saturday

Sept 22

These 24 hours fine weather got through cutting about noon lost the head still boiling saw several sails and so ends.

Sunday

Sept 23

These 24 hours fine weather and light breezes and calm still boiling saw several sails and a school of hampus so ends.
