Sunday Nov 18

Lat 36.52 First part of this day light breeze
By Obs from the NW Middle and Latter parts
Long 24.04 the same steering S by W saw two sails
By Chs. supposed to be whales at sun down took
sails and luffed to on the starboard tack
heading to the Westward and so ends.

Monday Nov 19 1872

First part of of this day blowing a gale
Barometer from the N ship on the starboard tack
30.3/10 heading to the Westward Middle part the
same at noon wore ship Latter part mod-
erate with a heavy swell rain and fog all
day. Saw nothing and so ends this day.

Tuesday Nov 20

First part of this day strong breeze
from the SW at day light made sail
ship on the starboard tack Middle
part the same at noon kept off steer-
ing N Latter part light breeze. Em-
ployed in shifting pork from the fore
hold to the after hold Broke out flour
and sugar and so ends.

Wednesday Nov 21

Lat 36.51 First part of this day moderate breeze
By Obs at day light made sail steering to the E Mid-
Lat 21.45 the and Latter parts the same saw several fin
By Chs. backs. put out the cutting stage and so ends.

Thursday Nov 22 1872

Lat 36.28 First part of this day light breeze Middle
By Obs part the same Latter part calm steering E
Long 21.45 by S at sun down took in sail. Saw several
By Chs. fin backs Thomas Toy off duty sick so ends.

Friday Nov 23 1872

Lat 36.40 First part of this day light breeze from
By Obs the NE Middle part the same Latter part
wind N steering E by S saw several fin backs
Broke out water employed in the rigging
and so ends this day.

Saturday Nov 24 1872

Lat 37.25 First part of these 24 hours light breeze
Long 18.10 from the N Middle and Latter parts the
same steering ESE saw several fin backs
and one seal and so ends.

Sunday Nov 25

First part light breeze from the NNE
Middle part the same Latter part blowing
heavy took in all sail except lower main
top sail saw one fin back and so ends.

Monday Nov 26

Lat 37.45 First part of this day blowing a gale
Long 16.22 from the NE Middle part moderating
Latter part the same steering E by N
saw nothing and so ends.

Tuesday Nov 27

Lat 36.57 First part of this day strong breeze
Long 13.09 steering E by S about 9 AM Mr. Brightman
raised a right whale lowered three boats
but did not strike Middle part steering
ESE at 5 PM saw the island of Tristan
at sun down took in sail and luffed to off inaccessible
