

Wednesday Friday Nov 28 1872
First part of this day light breeze at day light made sail and stood down by the large island about 10 A.M. a boat came off from the shore left about noon Middle part calm Latter part light air steering S.E. saw several fin backs and so ends.

Thursday Nov 29
Lat 37.15 First part of this day light breeze
Long 11.17 Middle and Latter parts the same steering S.E. Employed in the rigging and so ends.

Friday Nov 30
Lat 36.28 First part of this day moderate breeze
Long 8.28 steering N.E. Middle part heading E by S Latter part the same. Broke out water and so ends this day.

Saturday Dec 1
Lat 35.31 First part of this day strong breeze
Long 5.04 ship on the port tack heading E. by N Middle part heading E by S Latter part heading S.E. by E. Saw one grampus. Set up the gallant back stays fore and main ship under all sail and so ends.

Sunday Dec 2 1872
First part of this day light breeze Middle and Latter part the same steering E.S.E. saw a large number of fin backs and one sail and so ends.

Monday Dec 3
First part strong breeze from the S.E. Middle and Latter parts the same heading E by N Saw several fin backs

Tuesday December 4 1872
Lat 35.46 First part of this day strong breeze
Long 5.3 E Middle and Latter parts the same head S.E. by E. Repaired the main gallant sail and fore top mast stay sail as ends.

Wednesday Dec 5
Lat 36.40 First part of this day light breeze heading
Long 3.00 S.E. by E Middle and Latter parts the same Broke out water and bread. Saw a carcass and so ends.

Thursday Dec 6
First part light breeze Middle and Latter parts the same. steering E.S.E. saw one right whale lowered three boats and the whale went to windward did not fasten and so ends.

Friday Dec 7
Lat 36.35 First part of this day strong breeze
Long 5.28 Middle and Latter parts the same about 12 O'clock saw a right whale lowered three boats and the larboard boat struck took the whale along side about 2 P.M. and went to cutting finished about midnight so ends.

Saturday Dec 8
Lat 36.03 First part of this day strong breeze at
Long 8.13 day light started works ship steering E.S.E. about 4 1/2 P.M. saw two right whales lowered two boats the bow boat struck took him along side about dark and let him lay for the night still boiling.
