

Friday Jan 25 - 1873

Lat 42.02 First part of this day light baffling
Long 126.28 wind from the ENE heading ESE Middle
and Latter parts the same. Employed
in the rigging and drying bone ends.

Saturday Jan 26

Lat 42.35 First part light breeze from the ENE
Long 128.48 Middle and Latter parts the same steering
by the wind Employed in plaining the
decks. Broke out water so ends.

Sunday Jan 27

Lat 44.31 First part moderate breeze from NE by N
Long 130.50 Middle part the same Latter part wind
increasing Ship heading E to SE. Saw a
school of Blackfish and so ends.

Monday Jan 28

Lat 45.22 First part of this day strong breeze from
Long 133.30 the NE Middle and Latter parts the same
heading ESE and SE Employed in plain-
ing the decks and so ends.

Tuesday Jan 29

Lat 45.28 First part of this day strong breeze
Long 139.12 from NNE Ship steering ENE Weather
thick fog Middle and Latter parts
the same Employed in making scrub
brooms. Saw several schools of right-
whale porpoise and so ends this day.

Wednesday Jan 30

First part of this day strong breeze
from the NNE with fog and rain Middle
and Latter parts the same Ship ENE
and so end this day never to return.

Thursday Jan 31 - 1873

Lat 45.42 First part of this day strong breeze from
Long 147.25 the NW steering E by N Middle part blow-
ing on wind NNE blowing on strong
squalls split the fore gallant sail
took in sail to double reefed top sails fur-
led pit and main sail steering ENE Latter
part the same steering NE by E saw one fin
back and so ends this day.

Friday Feb 1 - 1873

Lat 44.35 First part blowing strong Middle and
Long 152.04 Latter parts the same Ship steering NE by E
Wind SW by W Employed in making scrub
brooms and plaining the decks aft so ends.

Saturday Feb 2 - 1873

Lat 43.26 First part of this day light breeze from the
Long 154.46 SW Weather fine. Steering NE Middle and
Latter parts the same. Rove new whips to
the main gallant sheets and repaired the
fore gallant sail and so ends this day.

Sunday Feb 3 - 1873

Lat 42.40 First part of this day moderate breeze and
Long 157.15 fine weather Wind SW Middle part the same
Latter part steering ENE. First and Middle
parts steering NE and so ends.

Monday Feb 4 1873

Lat 42.05 First part of this day light breeze from the
Long 160.04 SE Middle part moderate and fine weather
Latter part the same. Repaired the main
top mast stay sail and set up the stay
broke out beef and pork. Carpenter plaining
the decks. Saw a school of Blackfish.
Ship steering ENE and so ends.
