

Sunday March 17 1873

Lat 32.48 First part of this day light breeze from the S ship steering N N W under all sail. Middle and Latter parts the same. Saw one sail at sundown took in sail and hauled the head yards aback heading E N E and so ends.

Monday March 18

Lat 32.04 First part of this day steering N by W Middle part the same Latter part heading N by E saw one sail and a white water. Broke out water from the fore hold and put it down the main hatch way. Employed in mending the larboard boat and so ends this day.

Tuesday March 19

First part of this day light breeze Middle part the same Latter part - breezing Saw nothing at sun down took in sail to close reef main top sail and so ends this day.

Wednesday March 20

First part of this day blowing a gale from the S E ship on the port tack. Middle part the same with heavy rain Latter part blowing on took in main top sail and fore stay sail. Cooper sick so ends.

Thursday March 21

Lat 32.21 First part strong breeze from the S E ship under three close reef top sails with rain squalls Middle and Latter parts the same. to work on the boat at sun down took in sail.

Friday March 22 - 1873

Lat 31.29 First part of this day strong breeze from the S E Middle part the same. Ship under close reef top sails and fore sail. Latter part moderating set the pit and spanker saw nothing and so ends this day.

Saturday March 23

Lat 32.01 First part of this day good breeze from the N E at day light made all sail Middle part the same. Latter part calm Employed in the rigging so ends.

Sunday March 24

First part of this day light air and calms Middle and Latter parts the same saw a school of grampus and so ends this day.

Monday March 25

First part light air and calms Middle and Latter part the same heading E S E Saw nothing Broke out water and repaired the main sail at sun down took in sail and so ends this day.

Tuesday March 26

Lat 32.20 First part of this day light breeze from the N E Middle and Latter parts the same. Saw nothing. Broke out duck and marline. Repaired the jib at sun down took in sail and so ends.

Wednesday March 27

Lat 33.14 First part good breeze from N E Middle Long 178.52 and Latter parts the same at 3 P.M. tacked ship at sun down tacked and took in sail Repaired fore sail saw one fin back so ends.
