

Thursday March 28 1873

Lat 32.52 First part of this good breeze from
Long 177.43 the N N W Middle and Latter parts the
same. Saw one sail Repaired the misse
top sail. The cook sick at sun down
look in sail and so ends.

Friday March 29

Lat 31.52 First part of this day light breeze
Long 178.46 Middle and Latter parts the same
Broke out Beef and Pork and Beans
at sun down tacked ship heading S W by
S. saw nothing took in sail so ends.

Saturday March 30

Lat 31.38 First part light breeze from W N W at day
Long 179.42 light wore ship and made sail. Middle
at Latter parts the same at 2 P.M. tacked
Employed in ships duty, saw nothing
and so ends.

Sunday March 31

First part of this day light breeze
with rain and fog. Middle and Latter
parts the same saw nothing and so ends.

Monday April 1

Lat 31.12 First part light breeze at 7 A M
Long 179.116 raised a school of sperm whales
lowered four boats and the waist and
bow boats got one each Larboard boat
struck and drewed. Saw an American
steamer. wind light through out the
day. Saw a large number of whales.
and so ends this day.



Tuesday April 2 1873

Lat 30.38 First part good breeze from the eastward
Long 178.55 at day light commenced cut finished at
5 P.M. about 2 P.M. saw a school of sperm
whales along ways off. did not lower and
so ends this day.

Wednesday April 3

Lat 30.40 First part of this day light breeze
Long 178.36 at day light made sail and started the
works saw nothing Middle and Latter
parts the same and so ends this day.

Thursday April 4

First part of this day blowing strong from
the S W with rain still boiling set the try-
works sail Middle and Latter parts the
same saw nothing and so ends this day.

Friday April 5

First part of this day strong breeze. still
boiling nothing in sight Middle and
Latter parts the same and so ends.

Saturday April 6

First part of this day fine weather and
light breeze at day light finished boiling
Broke out water and molasses. Saw a wha-
ling Bark and one ship and so ends.

Sunday April 7

Lat 31.10 First part of this day fine weather and
Long 178.33 Light breeze at 8 A.M. spoke the Bark
Madley Capt Soul 20 months out 200 all
told saw nothing and so ends.
