

Tuesday May 7-1873

Lat-29.14 First-part of this day good breeze from
 Lat-178.16 the S.W. at day light made sail and kept
 off N.E. Middle and Latter parts the same
 at 2 P.M. raised Sunday island at sun
 down took in sail and layed aback
 during the night the island bearing N.W.
 distance 20 miles. Saw one fin balek
 and Goat island finished setting the
 main rigging and so ends this day.

Wednesday May 8

Lat-29.35 First-part of this day light breeze from
 Long 178.44 S.E. at day light made all sail ship on
 the port-tack heading S.W. Middle and
 latter parts the same saw Sunday and
 Goat islands. Broke out molasses at
 sun down took in sail and so ends.

Thursday May 9

Lat-29.50 First-part of this day light air and
 Long 178.00 Calme at day light made sail steering
 S.W. Middle and Latter parts the same
 started water saw one fin balek and a
 school of grampus and Goat island
 and so ends this day.

Friday May 10

First-part of this day light breeze
 from the N.W. ship on the port-tack
 heading S.W. Middle and Latter
 parts the same. Saw two sails so ends.

Saturday May 11

Lat-30.45 First-part blowing strong breeze from N.W.
 Long 178.6 At 10 raised a school of sperm whales lowered
 three boats about 3 P.M. the larboard boat
 struck the whale along side about 5 P.M.

Sunday May 12 1873

First-part of this day strong breeze from the
 N.W. at day light made sail commenced
 to cut finished at 11 A.M. at 4 P.M. started
 the try works. saw nothing and so ends.
 Middle and Latter parts light-breeze.

Monday May 13.

Lat-30.06 First-part light-breeze at day light Peter
 Long 178.20 Ende raised a school of whales in company
 with the Barke Elina and Hadley lowered four
 boats. Elina three Hadley three chased until
 sun down with out success finished boiling
 at 7 P.M. Capt. Dimond came aboard. Middle and
 Latter parts light-breeze. saw another sail so ends.



Tuesday May 14

Lat-29.50 First-part of this day light air and calms
 Long 178.35 Middle and Latter parts the same. Saw a
 school of grampus and two sails and so ends.

Wednesday May 15

Lat-30.04 First-part of this day light breeze from
 Long 177.49 the S.E. ship working to the S. Middle
 and Latter parts the same. Started water
 saw two sails and a school of grampus
 and so ends this day.

Thursday May 16

Lat-30.16 First-part of this day light breeze from the
 Long 178.15 S.E. ship working to the S. Middle part
 the same Latter part calms Employed
 in stowing down. made a pair of new
 slings. Saw nothing and so ends this day.
