

Friday July 26 1873

First part of this day light breeze from NW at day light saw Savage island keep off for it and ^{run} down on the west side about 2 P.M. sent a boat ashore. but was not able to get any thing today. Latter part strong breeze from the SSE with rain took in sail and stood off and on during the night so ends.

Saturday July 27

First part of this day light breeze from the NE about 8 1/2 A.M. sent in a boat. Got some yams, coconuts, fowls, and turkeys and 17 hogs. Latter part wind SE ship steering SW. John Harvey deserted from the ship and so ends this day.

Sunday July 28

Lat 20.21 First part of this day strong breeze from the SE ship steering SW Middle and Latter parts the same ship on the wind heading SSE. Saw one fin back. Killed pig so ends.

Monday July 29

Lat 22.37 Long 173.00 First part of this day moderate breeze from the SE ship on the port tack heading SSW Middle and Latter parts strong breeze saw several fin backs startled water and bread. Painted waist boat and so ends this day.

Tuesday July 30

Lat 25.13 Long 173.02 First part strong breeze from the ESE ship steering SSE Middle and Latter parts the same saw several fin backs so ends.

Wednesday July 31 1873

Lat 26.34 First part of this day good breeze from the N ship steering S by E Middle and Latter parts strong breeze ship on the wind heading W. Saw several fin backs killed a pig and so ends this day.

Thursday Aug 1

First part of this day blowing strong ship under short sail Middle part the same. Latter part moderating saw several fin backs and so ends this day.

Friday Aug 2

First part of this day moderate breeze from the SE ship heading W Middle part the same Latter part strong breeze weather thick and cloudy. Saw nothing at sun down wore ship so ends.

Saturday Aug 3

Lat 26.15 First part of this day blowing strong from the SE about 7 A.M. kept off steering NNNW ship under three lower top sails Middle part took in fore and main top sails Latter part still blowing started beef and so ends.

Sunday Aug 4

First part of this day blowing a gale from the ESE ship on the port tack heading S ship under main spencer Middle and Latter parts the same and so ends.

Monday Aug 5

First part moderating made lower main top sail. but it soon came on took it in weather thick and rainy. Wind NE so ends.
