

Thursday ~~Tuesday~~ Aug 15-1873
 First part of this day strong breeze from the SE at day light made sail and stood in shoal and lowered the two boats and sent them into the land after game the larboard boat was capsized doing through the reef Middle and Latter parts wind light about 2 P.M. the boats returned with game and fruit at sun down shortened sail and hauled off shore with the head yards aback and so ends.

Friday Aug 16
 First part of this day good breeze at day light made sail and kept off down the reef. Middle and Latter parts the same. Saw nothing. Employed in taring down. at sun down luffed to the windward of Round Island distance 20 miles and so ends this day.

Saturday Aug 17
 First part of this day strong breeze from the E with heavy rain took in all sail except lower main top sail. Middle part clear made sail. Latter part calm. Saw round island at sun down hauled off shore head yards aback so ends.

Sunday Aug 18
 Lat 16.40 Long 176.52 First part of this day light breeze from the SE ship heading along the land. Middle part the same. Latter part calm at sun down luffed off shore and so ends.

Monday Aug 18-1873
 First part of this day light breeze from the SE at day light made all sail and stood down the reef Middle part the same Latter part calm at sun down ship of the Island of Riva. Employed in taring down so ends this day.

Tuesday Aug 20
 Lat 17.25 Long 176.38 First part of this day light air and Calms Middle and Latter parts the same. Saw two hump backs and a school of grampus. Repaired the spanker and and tared the mizen rigging and so ends this day.

Wednesday Aug 21
 Lat 18.05 Long 176.57 First part of this day light breeze from the SE Middle and Latter parts the wind increasing. Ship bearing to the Eward along the land. Employed in taring down saw one hump back and so ends this day.

Thursday Aug 22
 Lat 18.40 Long 177.32 First part of this day strong breeze from the SE. Ship bearing along the land to the S and E Middle and Latter parts the same Overhauled the lashings to the cutting shackles and tared them at sun down the Island of Kantar bore SE distance 20 miles off and so ends this day.

Friday Aug 23
 First part of this day light breeze from the SE about 8 A.M. lowered the starboard boat and the Captain went ashore on the West side of Kantar. got off about 6 or 7 game stood off and on during the night so ends.
