

Tuesday Sept 3 1873

Lat 24.10 This 24 come blowing strong from the
Long 167.37 ESE at day light commenced to cut
to the windward finished about noon
one whale. Wore round and cut the
other finished the body at dark and let
the head lay. Cleared away and started
the works during the night and so ends.

Wednesday Sept 4

Lat 24.15 First part of this day moderate breeze
Long 167.10 from the ESE. at 8 A.M. took in the head
and cleared it away. Still boiling. Ship
on the port-tack heading S Middle and
Latter parts the same and so ends.

Thursday Sept 5

Lat 25.02 First part of this day strong breeze from
Long 167.12 the E. at 7 A.M. raised a whale. wore round
and run off but never saw him again.
Still boiling. Middle and Latter parts
the same. Broke out a new bailer so ends.

Friday Sept 6

First part of this day strong breeze
from the NE with rain. Middle part
the same Latter part blowing strong
saw nothing. Still boiling and so ends.

Saturday Sept 7

First part of this day blowing strong
from the NW with rain. Middle and Latter
parts the same. Saw nothing. finished
boiling about sun down the whale.
Turned up 140 barrels and so ends.

Sunday Sept 8 1873

First part of this day blowing a gale
from the SW with rain. ship under close
reef top sail. Saw nothing. middle and
Latter parts the same and so ends.

Monday Sept 9

First part of this day blowing a gale
from the W at day commenced to stow
down in the main hatch way. got down
all the oil except ten barrels. Middle
and Latter parts the same so ends.

Tuesday Sept 10

Lat 25.04 First part of this day still blowing
Long 168.44 at day light wore ship and finished
stowing the oil and filled about 65 barrels
of salt water. Broke out a cask of bread
Middle and Latter parts moderating
Washed ship. At sun down wore ship
heading NW on the port-tack and so ends.

Wednesday Sept 11

Lat 25.13 First part of this day light breeze from
Long 168.44 the NW at day light made all sail.
Middle and Latter parts the same. Saw
one fin back and a school of grampse
Repaired the lower maintop sail and
and bent a new upper main top sail
and so ends this day.

Thursday Sept 12

Lat 25.20 First part of this day strong breeze
from the SW ship under sheet sail. Mid-
dle part the same Latter part blowing a
gale broke out butter and molasses
saw two hump backs and so ends.
