

Sunday Sept-29 1873

First-part of this day light-breeze from the N.W. ship heading N.E. About 9 A.M. spoke Bark Hunter Capt. Holt - 2 years out - 2200 all told. Sold him two coils of twine. Saw one fin back Middle and Latter parts the same at sun down took in sail and so ends.

Monday Sept-30

Lat-27.10 First-part of this day light-baffling winds ship working to the N Middle and Latter parts the same. Saw several hump backs and one sail. Started water at sun down took in sail heading E and so ends.

Tuesday October 1

Lat-27.24 Long-167.47 First-part of this day light-breeze from the N.W. ship heading N. Middle and Latter parts the same. Saw several hump backs the Captain Blacksmithing and so ends.

Wednesday Oct-2

First-part of this day light-air and calms Middle and Latter parts light-breeze from the N.W. ship on the port-tack heading N by W. Saw one sail. Broke out 28 tins of pork and coopered it. At sun down took in sail and so ends this day.

Thursday Oct-3

Lat-26.00 Long-168.27 First-part of this day light-breeze ship steering N Middle parts the same Latter part wind S.E. steering N.W. Saw one sail. Broke out Beef and Pork at sun down took in sail and so ends.

Friday Oct-4-1873

Lat-25.01 Long-167.31 First-part of this day light-breeze from the E.S. ship steering N.W. Middle part steering W Latter part luffed too on the starboard tack heading N.E. Saw nothing at sun down took in sail and so ends this day.

Saturday Oct-5

First-part of this light-breeze from the E.S. ship under all sail cruising Middle and Latter parts the same. Saw several fin backs and so ends this day.

Sunday Oct-6

Lat-26.24 Long-168.29 First-part of this day light-breeze from the N.W. at day light made all sail steering S.E. Middle part and Latter parts strong breeze shortened sail. Saw two sails at 4 1/2 P.M. spoke the Bark Hunter Capt. Holt who reports having lost a large whale yesterday and so ends this day.

Monday Oct-7

First-part of this day good breeze from the N.W. at day light made all sail. Ship on the port-tack heading N.W. by N. Middle and Latter parts the same. Saw one sail and several fin backs and so ends this day.

Tuesday Oct-8

First-part of this day light-breeze from the N.W. at day light - whole ship and made sail heading S.W. Middle and Latter parts good breeze weather fine. Saw a large body of fin backs at sun down took in all ball to lower main top sail and so ends.
