

Monday Nov 25 - 1873

Lat 33.41 First part of this day blowing a gale from the S with rain. Middle part the same. Latter part moderating a little. Ship on the port tack under main spencer and so ends this day.

Tuesday Nov 26

Lat 33.36 First part of this day blowing strong from the S. Ship on the starboard tack heading to the Eastward under fore sail and lower main top sail and close reef minnen top sail. Middle and Latter parts the same. Saw several fin backs and one sail at sun down took in the fore sail and minnen top sail and so ends this day.

Wednesday Nov 27

Lat 33.43 First part of this day strong breeze from the S ship heading to E Middle and Latter parts moderating. Saw one fin back started flour and so ends.

Thursday Nov 28

Lat 34.08 First part of this day good breeze from the S & E ship on the port tack heading S & E. Middle and Latter parts the same. Repaired the fore top mast stay sail saw nothing. Started water and bread and flour at sun down took in sail and so ends this day.

Friday Nov 29

Lat 34.40 First part of this day light breeze at 7 A.M. wore ship heading N by S Middle and Latter parts calm. Saw one sail and several fin backs. Repaired the main sail and so ends.

Saturday Nov 30 - 1873

First part of this day good breeze from the N ship steering S W by S Middle part the same. Latter part thick and rainy. Saw nothing. Broke out the sail cask and so ends this day.

Sunday Dec 1

Lat 36.24 First part of this day light air and calm. Middle part blowing a gale from the S & E ship on the port tack heading S W under lower main top sail. Latter part the same at sun down took in the main top sail. Turned up the starboard boat and so ends this day.

Monday Dec 2

Lat 36.50 First part of this day strong breeze from the S & E but moderating at daylight made the lower top sails and fore sail sail. Middle part the same set the jib. Latter part saw two fin backs and one sail at sun down took in sail and so ends this day.

Tuesday December 3

Lat 36.20 First part of this day good breeze from the S & E at daylight made sail ship on the port tack heading N & E Middle part strong breeze took in the light sails. Latter part moderating. Saw one fin back. Started water forward and put it down the after hole at sun down took in sail and so ends.

Wednesday Dec 4

First part strong breeze from the S & E ship on the starboard tack about 10 A.M. spoke the Flying Childers of Robert Town 9 months out clean. Saw a school of porpoise. at sun down wore ship and took in sail and so ends.
