

Wednesday Jan 22-1874

Lat 35.27 First part of this day moderate breeze from NNE. Ship on the port tack heading ESE. Middle and Latter parts the same. Repaired larboard boat. Saw one sail and several fin backs and so ends.

Thursday Jan 23

Lat 35.26 First part of this day good breeze from the N ship working to the N and E. Middle and Latter parts the same. Employed in the rigging set up the fore rigging. Saw several fin backs carried sail all night and so ends this day.

Friday Jan 24

Lat 35.18 First part of this day moderate breeze from the NNE ship heading NE. Middle part the same Latter part wind NNE steering N by E. Saw one fin back. Employed in the rigging. Broke out flour and so ends.

Saturday Jan 25

Lat 34.25 First part of this day light breeze from the W ship steering N by E Middle and Latter parts wind from the E ship on the starboard tack heading NE. Saw one sail. Put up new fore gallant rigging started water and so ends this day.

Sunday Jan 26

First part of this day strong breeze from the ship on the starboard tack heading NNE Middle and Latter parts the same. Weather thick and hazy. Saw nothing and so ends.

Monday Jan 27-1874

Lat 32.56 First part of this day light breeze from the Long 167.35 NNE and fine weather. Ship on the port tack heading E Middle and Latter parts the same. Saw a school of grampus. Repaired the Bob stay and so ends this day.

Tuesday Jan 28

Lat 33.10 First part of this day light breeze from N by E Long 168.25 ship heading E by S Middle and Latter parts the same. Saw nothing Carpenter repairing the bow boat. and so ends this day.

Wednesday Jan 29

Lat 32.55 First part of this day light breeze from the Long 169.07 ENE. Ship on the starboard tack heading N Middle and Latter parts the same. Still repairing the bow boat. Rattled the fore gallant rigging. Saw two fin backs so ends.

Thursday Jan 30

Lat 32.03 First part of this day good breeze from the Long 170.18 SE ship on the starboard tack heading ENE Middle and Latter parts the same. Saw nothing. finished bow boat and started water and so ends this day.

Friday Jan 31st

First part of this day light breeze from the SSE ship heading E Middle and Latter parts the same. Saw one fin back. Employed in making spun yarn and so ends.

Saturday Feb 1

First part light breeze from the NE ship heading ESE Middle and Latter parts the same. Saw nothing. Washed the ship out side. Repaired the main gallant stay sail and so ends.
