

Thursday Feb 13-1874

First part of this day good breeze from the NE ship working to the E Middle and Latter parts the same. Saw nothing at sun down shortened sail and so ends this day.

Friday Feb 14

Lat 32.52 Long 178.55 First part of this day light breeze from the SE ship on the port tack heading SSW. Middle part the same Latter part wore round heading ENE and spoke the Bark Rainbow Capt Gray at sun down took in sail and so ends this day.

Saturday Feb 15

First part of this day strong breeze from the ESE ship on the starboard tack heading NE under short sail. middle and Latter parts moderating. Saw one sail. at sun down took in sail and so ends this day.

Sunday Feb 16

Lat 32.00 Long 179.50 First part of this day strong breeze from the NNE ship heading E. Weather thick middle and Latter parts the same. About 1 P.M. Antone De Cruise raised a school of whales going to the windward lowered three boats and did not fasten at dark took in sail and so ends this day.

Monday Feb 17

Lat 31.35 Long 178.44 First part of this day strong breeze from the E Middle and Latter parts the same about 10 A.M spoke the Bark Osmanti Capt Williams 1500 all told saw three other sails at sun down took in sail so ends.

Tuesday Feb 18-1874

Lat 31.18 First part of this day strong breeze and thick weather. Middle and Latter parts the same started water. flour and coffee. Saw four sails at sun down took all sail except lower main top sail and so ends this day.

Wednesday Feb 19

First part of this day blowing a gale from the SE Middle part the same Latter part wind hauled in to the SW ship on the port tack. Saw nothing and so ends.

Thursday Feb 20

Lat 31.32 Long 179.50 First part of this day strong breeze from the NW at day light made the lower top sails and fore sail. Weather thick most of the time. Middle and Latter parts the same. Saw one sail. at sun down took in sail to lower main top sail so ends.

Friday Feb 21

First part of this day moderate breeze from the NW by W and thick and rainy. Middle part the same Latter part calm. Saw nothing at sun down took in sail to lower main top sail and so ends this day.

Saturday Feb 22

Lat 31.30 Long 179.02 First part of this day light breeze from the NNE ship on the starboard tack heading NW under all sail middle and Latter parts the same. Saw a school of grampus at sun down took in sail and so ends this day.
